- 1. In view of the number of cyclist fatalities and serious injuries on roads, the school is concerned about the safety of pupils if they choose to cycle to school.

- 2. Taking into consideration the road safety hazards for cyclists, cycling to school is therefore not the preferred mode of transport. Cycling at a young age should be reserved for recreational purposes at safer places such as parks and on Park Connectors. Please note that no motorised bicycle is allowed.
